PERSEPOLIS The menu at Persepolis (1423 Second Avenue, at 74th Street; 212-535-1100) seems similar to those of its west Asian neighbors – Kebabs, Meze – but this Persian restaurant also has a delicious and unusual Stew of the day.

Gheimeh is made with lentils and filet mignon; Fesenjoon is Chicken in a walnut and pomegranate sauce, and Ghormeh Sabzi blends spinach, lamb and beans. There is also a vegetarian version of the Gheimeh with eggplant. Each is \$ 14
